

F.O.N.C. EDUCATION POLICY

It is the policy of the Friends of Nunhead Cemetery that the cemetery be used for educational purposes, consistent with its status as a place of burial and remembrance. This shall be aimed at promoting knowledge of the history and ecology of the cemetery in both specific and general terms and in understanding the current status of the cemetery.

Such educational purposes may be both formal and informal. Formal education activities may be through Council/FONC organised schools/college/special interest visits, guided tours, interpretive material etc. Informal education activities may be through provision of written material and on-site interpretive boards etc. for the benefit of general visitors.

Educational activities shall also be promoted off site by the production of various publications, assisting with family history research, giving of lectures, participating in exhibitions and events etc.
