

F.O.N.C. NUNHEAD CEMETERY ANNUAL OPEN DAY POLICY

1. It is the policy of the Friends of Nunhead Cemetery that an annual Open Day should be held in Nunhead Cemetery, with the purpose of bringing the existence of the cemetery to the attention of the general public. This shall include promoting the historical, ecological and bereavement aspects of the cemetery and promoting the work of the Friends of Nunhead Cemetery.
2. The event shall be held in cooperation with the site owners (Southwark Council (LBS)). The event shall be organised by FONC members appointed by the General Committee, with the agreement of the site manager and any other officers nominated by LBS. Attendance by the general public shall be at their own risk.
3. Admission to the Open Day shall be open to all, save those whose behaviour becomes unsafe, anti-social or in other ways disruptive, and shall be free of charge.
4. The General Committee of the Friends of Nunhead Cemetery shall invite other relevant groups/organisations to participate in the Open Day as it sees fit and shall reserve the right to exclude such groups/organisations at its discretion. Acceptance of an invitation shall be deemed acceptance of the provisions of this document and direction on the Open Day by appointed FONC supervisors.
5. Invitations to other groups/bodies to participate shall be restricted to those bodies/groups that the General Committee considers to share similar aims and objectives as FONC (e.g. other cemetery friends' groups); promote aims and objectives that are sympathetic to those of FONC (e.g. historical societies, flora, fauna and environmental preservation/promotion societies); have a specific connection with the cemetery (e.g. Amnesty International's connection with the Scottish Martyrs); promote local services pertinent to the cemetery (e.g. Council dog warden schemes).
6. Stalls shall not be overtly commercial in nature. The sale of jumble shall not be permitted. The display of material deemed unsuitable by the organisers shall not be permitted.
